
WHEREAS, Incident Billing Services require an additional fee for service not provided for in the general funding of the fire district; and

## APPENDIX A: INCIDENT FEE SCHEDULE:

Incident Rate	Description
Rescue Rate 1: \$150	MVC, No Rescue Tools Used, Less than 0.5 Hours On Scene
Rescue Rate 2: \$500	MVC, No Rescue Tools Used, up to 1 Hour On Scene
Rescue Rate 3: \$1500	MVC, No Rescue Tools Used, Greater than 1 Hour On Scene
Rescue Rate 4: \$650	MVC, Rescue Tools Used, Less than 1 Hour on Scene
Rescue Rate 5: \$1650	MVC, Rescue Tools Used, Greater than 1 Hour on Scene
Rescue Rate 6: \$750	MVC Involving Extrication, Less than 1 Hour On Scene
Rescue Rate 7: \$1750	MVC Involving Extrication, Greater than 1 Hour on Scene
Motor Vehicle Fire: \$500	Extinguishment of Motor Vehicle Fire
Gas Line Break 1: \$500	On Scene Less than 1 Hour
Gas Line Break 2: \$1000	On Scene Longer than 1 Hour
Hazmat 1: \$300	Spills less than 10 gallons requiring use of absorbent, on scene less than 0.5 Hours
Hazmat 2: \$750	Spills greater than 10 gallons requiring use of absorbent, on scene up to 1 hour. \$750 for each additional hour.
False Alarm: \$250	Each Incident after 3 <sup>rd</sup> False Alarm
